Comments: Random review of child files. One file only has 1 emergency contact. To be updated with another.

<p>Comments: Outdoor Play Area: Standing water present within multiple tires outside of fenced area (some children were playing outside fence today). Remove tires, or drill holes to allow water to drain.</p> <p>Group Logs: Date group established should not be changing more than once per week within each bubble. Ensure date group established reflects the date that group was formed, and that this date only changes on the document when a new child joins that bubble. The grouping method (see COVID-19 Recovery Phase document, p. 6) limits any one grouping to a maximum of 15 children. In order to accommodate children enrolled, operator may divide preschool room in half and operate as two separate bubble groupings. Should this occur, each side of the room must be set up with a variety of materials from various interest centers for each group of children. Clear signage to define common walkways (near cubbies and to access washrooms) must be identified and discussed with the children. Low level shelving may be used to divide the room, but social distancing must be maintained between groups. Washroom use was also discussed if the group is divided. In order to reduce the crossing of bubble groupings and cleaning practices, each preschool group could be assigned one washroom and one sink to use. Washrooms must still be cleaned frequently.</p> <p>Diaper changing: Garbage cans used for diapers must have a lid. Diapering garbage can was missing lid twice today during inspection. Discussed with educator and operator.</p> <p>Updated diaper changing procedures are posted at one change table, but not the other-to be updated with newest procedure.</p>

Comments: Latch on infant fence is not lining up and in need of repair to latch properly.

Comments: Some toys/equipment in need of cleaning: Preschool room: Car track/Gas station, Bat house, and Paw Patrol lookout Infant room: Pink car The seat on small black chair within infant room has peeled off-to be repaired or removed.			
46(1) An operator of a licensed facility shall only administer medication to a child receiving services at the licensed facility in the following cases: (c) if the medication is not prescribed, the medication is (i) in the original container with the original label, (ii) in a container with child protective caps (iii) labelled with the child's name and the dosage.	46(1)(c)	Nov 16, 2020	
Comments: Obtain dosage amount from parents for children who have Benadryl on site for anaphylaxis. Indicate dosage on bottle. When medication is required as part of a child's extreme allergy management plan, this is not required to be locked with other medications. This medication should be accessible to staff in an emergency, but inaccessible to the children.			

General Comments

Completed renewal inspection today. Children appeared very content within their environment and were very comfortable with their routines. The children were observed to be engaged in a variety of areas (creative art, literacy, dramatic play, construction and especially enjoyed exploring the outdoors).

Educators followed the children's lead and adjusted their daily schedule (ate lunch later than usual) to accommodate the children's wishes to remain outdoors.

Broken toys, plastic and debris is accumulating outdoors outside of the fenced in play area-to be picked up/removed. Larger toys/structures that are not being used (located in larger garden box) to be moved to storage. Ensure staff are completing outside checklist to monitor this on a regular basis and that toys are being stored appropriately and disposed of when broken.

The climbing dome outside of the fence was not used today. This should not be used unless it is surrounded by protective surfacing.

Discussed Intro to ECE course for some staff-operator was provided with registration information and will enroll staff for next session. Confirmation of enrollment emails to be placed in staff files.
