order to access exit and washrooms.

Educators were observed interacting with the children at their level indoors and outdoors today.

The two year old children were observed exploring their environment outdoors and they wore their masks when re-entering the building as they walked to their room. Medication has been moved from the cupboard under the sink to a locked storage closet within the 2 year old room.

Discussed toilet training for one child and that this will require the support of a "floater" staff member. This staff member must wear their mask at all times and also wash their hands prior to and after returning a child to their designated bubble group.
