General Comments

Children and educators observed engaged in a variety of activities in the outdoor play area this morning including sand play, exploring large loose parts, climbing, throwing, digging and dumping. A variety of outdoor play materials are accessible to the children to explore freely. The children are currently growing vegetables in the garden.

Purposeful planning is evident through documentation displayed throughout the indoor play area. Documentation includes learning stories, photos, open ended art pieces and children's words. Each child has a portfolio filled with documentation of their learning experiences.

Hand washing routines were observed during washroom routines, after outdoor play and before lunch. Monthly fire drills are documented.

Daily attendance forms are completed and accurate.
