| Comments: As per discussed during the licensing staff visit, it is important that hallways are kept free of excess materials as this is considered a fire escape route out of the home, storage bins should not be stored in the area that children use for play, and the playspace should be set up and ready during operational hours. The operator will also set up her outdoor play area to reflect the curriculum and provide a bin for outdoor toys and pylons or other type of marker so children are familiar with the boundary of the outdoor play space. The Operator will also mend the fence and place a secure lock on the pool gate fence. The kitty litter cannot be stored in the bathroom used by the children during operating hours. |            |                      |                |

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| <p><b>General Comments</b></p> <p>This is a follow up monitoring inspection.</p> <p>Licensing staff received an email from the operator on October 27th indicating the date the Orders for compliance were completed for the above items.</p> <p>There are 2 outstanding compliances and one new compliance. The Operator indicated she is still waiting to have her fire extinguisher returned so it still being serviced. The requirement for the outdoor play space was discussed further and once this space has been set up and is meeting the requirements for curriculum, please advise.</p> <p>Attendance records were reviewed during my visit, and this is being documented with exception of November 25 through to December 2nd. Please ensure you document attendance even when you are closed (due to illness, vacation, other reasons) so departmental personnel are aware.</p> |
