General Comments

Operator set out invitations for music and a coordinated activity to make money for a pretend store. Other indoor play materials that were out and available were books and trucks. Other play materials were accessible in bins at the children's level.

Operator sat with the children and actively engaged with them during play and during lunch, supporting where needed with feeding children. Operator prompted reminders for handwashing between activities.

Operator redirected behaviours, using a calm even tone, when needed to ensure the safety of children, such as

redirecting children when they threw toy cars. Operator comforted children when they were upset and supported them in resolving conflicts by encouraging behaviours like sharing, turn taking,

Labelled bins with the children's names were observed with their personal items inside. These were on a low shelf by the door of the playroom, accessible to the children. Drawings by some of the children were observed on the walls.

Fire extinguisher was observed to be maintained during this visit; this order is now in compliance.
