General Comments

Today during licensing staff follow up to inspection requirements, three young children were present. Licensing staff observed indoor play opportunities, and when I asked about the morning routine and if the children would be going outside, the Operator said, "Yes we could do that".

The Operator and children were dressed warmly, and they decided to bring out toys and materials so they could make pretend ice-cream snow sundaes. Children enjoyed this activity, then they played and enjoyed making snow angels, and beating down a path in the snow.

The outdoor walkway needs sanded/salted as it presents a safety hazard - it if very icy. as per stated above. Once this compliance is addressed licensing staff will recommend for licensing.
