## **General Comments**

Upon Licensing staff arrival, the children were sitting together having a snack. The Operator was engaged in conversation with the children and once finished, the children played freely.

The main space has bins and accessible shelves for trucks and cars. Additional play material such as musical instruments, dolls and accessories, a wooden shelf with play kitchen food and appliances, a cupboard with board games and puzzles, and an art table with a roll of paper, small tins hanging with markers and crayons were tidy and in good condition. The children and the Operator were observed playing together with board games and puzzles. While working on a puzzle, positive words of encouragement and praise were heard such as "Good Job!" and "Way to go!". The Operator was observed explaining to the children how transition to a new activity. The children were encouraged to help each other clean up before taking out a new game to keep things tidy before starting something new. Throughout the main room, laminated pages were on the wall with the children's names in bright colours, their photos and their favorite things. Also, colourful cut outs and pages with positive words of affirmation were on display.

Later in the morning, the children went outside to play. The children were given the choice on which toys they wanted to take outside. The children chose to take musical instruments such as bells, maracas, and a small drum as well as play strollers. Children were dressed appropriately with hats, mittens, and snowsuits but it was a bit windy and cold so outdoor playtime was half an hour. Once back inside, children's belongings were hung up on hooks with their names in the main entryway. Once back downstairs, the children played while waiting for lunch. Before lunch, the table was cleaned and each child was provided lunch once sitting together at the table.

Monthly fire drills are being completed and logged and attendance is being completed daily. Child profiles are complete, and the parent board was organized and required information was visible. During the inspection, recommendations were made for how to incorporate elements of nature indoors and how to display children's artwork.
