General Comments								
The educators have worked hard in removing clutter and providing more learning centres for the children within their spaces. Pictures, artwork and learning stories are ways inwhich the educators are documenting the children's learning. Licensing staff spoke with the administrator and we both feel that the educators could benefit from a referral to the curriculum team for support. The environment is calm, and educators were very kind to the children. They were seen engaged with them; having conversations and playing with them. The educators primary focus was on the children. Please ensure that educators that come from other provinces have a vulnerable sector and criminal record check conducted from where they currently reside prior to employment. Please ensure the cupboard with toxic products remain locked at all times. The natural components and the learning centres that have been created in the outdoor play space were great to see. The administrator has built wooden vehicles, added a tunnel, there is a kitchen, art area, a stick area, ride on toy area and basket ball area to name a few. The space utilization is more complete and will attract a variety of interests of the children. The Operator has sufficient shade for the outdoor play areas. Files are meticulous and licensing staff was able to easily verify information. I can now recommend facility for licensing.
