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General Comments Licensing staff arrived in the morning to conduct a monitoring visit. The operator only had one child present and when I arrived, they were outside gathering up pinecones. There was a squirrel throwing pinecones at them and the operator made a video of this that she will share with the parents later. The outdoor play area is well set up for the children with a fairy garden, mud kitchen and paths through the wooded area beside the house. There is an abundance of loose parts, art supplies and places for imaginative play and fine motor and gross motor activities. We pretend fed the wooden deer cutouts and there was space to ride the child's bicycle, but he chose to go inside instead. The inside play area is set up just for the childcare, with a bathroom available, space for the children's belongings, a couch and table, books, building blocks and arts and craft materials to name a few. The operator is trying to prioritize a natural environment and there are plants and wicker baskets to hold the toys etc. The child has a great interest in pipes and plumbing right now and they were exploring themes of work such as plumbing and cooking. The Operator had some lovely learning stories posted featuring a cooking story and a plumbing story. She extended the learning for him with tools such as pipes and hoses, a toolbox and plunger as well as printing pictures of different kinds of pipes for him to explore. The daily schedule is posted with words and pictures illustrating the format of the day and the parent board is complete and up to date. After some block building and guitar playing it was time for lunch. All food was brought from home and then it was story time. Hallowe'en is the big theme and Spooky Wheels on the Bus by J. Elizabeth Mills one of the favourites. Nap time was announced and the transition was easy and calm. The operator is patient and kind and interested and engaged with the child. She is very aware of the NB Curriculum and is very good at co-creating it with the children in her care.
