<p>General Comments</p> <p>Visit to facility for annual inspection (during COVID-19). Ratio was respected during visit.</p> <p>-Recommended a visit from Public Health inspector to ensure that COVID-19 guidelines are being properly followed. Asked operator/staff to remove items that cannot be sanitized ex: cardboard and toys with hair). Recommended children have individualized bins/bags in order to assist with sanitation.</p> <p>-Recommended the operator review to owners manual for the little tikes structure in the afterschool playground to ensure proper protective surfacing. No protecting surfacing at this time, recommended the structure not be used until protective surfacing is put in place.</p> <p>-Discussed with operator/administrator child guidance and developing intervention plans for staff for children with difficult behaviors.</p> <p>-Ensure that addresses of emergency contacts are completed in all child profiles.</p> <p>-Ensure that all incident reports are signed by parents.</p> <p>-Discussed proper supervision of children during nap time in infant room.</p>
