11(c)(ii) The qualifications and training requirements for administrators and educators are as follows: (c) at a full-time or part-time early learning and childcare centre, (ii) on and after July 1, 2020, (A) at least 50% of educators must hold a one-year Early Childhood Education Certificate or training that is equivalent in the opinion of the Minister, and (B) an administrator must hold a one-year Early Childhood Education Certificate or training that is equivalent in the opinion of the Minister.	11(c)(ii)	Jun 30, 2022	
Comments: Three educators have presently completed their first year of the ECE course, three others are going to take the course starting September 2021.

Comments: Recommended removing large bulky items / furniture out of the school aged room to all for more space for children to move around/do activities. Large furniture limits children's ability to move freely indoors. Recommended that other rooms be looked at in order to determine if large wooden structures/furniture is needed. This will allow for children to move more freely.

Comments: Discussed with operator and administrator the classroom environments and how need to be more developed in each classroom. The facility has an over abundance of materials; however, they are not always accessible, available or displayed in an inviting to children. For example, an art area should include different types of crayons, markers, glue, scissors, paper, craft supplies all at the children's disposal. Play areas should be inviting with items available and on display, for example, the infant room kitchenette should have utensils, pots, pans, mixing bowls, food etc, rather than be stored away. In all classrooms, a literacy area should be easily accessible with books on display. Overall recommending more materials be brought out that reflect the environment trying to be created. Materials brought out should also reflect children's interests.

<p>Visit to facility for annual inspection. School aged children were not present</p> <p>Ratio was respected during the visit.</p> <p>Reminder to add first aid certificates and 90hr course certificates to staff files once they are received.</p> <p>Administrator was able to show proof of completion by emails and receipts.</p> <p>Majority of incident reports are signed by parents, ensure that all reports are always signed.</p> <p>Milk bottles were in a child's lunch box with ice packs. As per the regulation milk bottles must be refrigerated with the name of the child on the bottle. This was completed while I was at the facility.</p> <p>The curriculum consultants' team is presently working with the facility in order to support curriculum work, staff leadership and guidance and environments. A follow up with this team and the facility will be completed.</p> <p>Observations:</p> <p>Children were being dropped off to the facility as I was arriving. Shortly after the infants and preschool aged groups went to play outside.</p> <p>They spent the morning outside until it was time to come in for lunch and nap.</p>
