Operator is aware that a staff member who works directly with infants or preschool children shall complete in each year 10 hours of training approved by the Minister related to the curriculum used at the designated facility.  Observations: Various types of documentation are present in each room that display the children's interests and what they are learning. School aged children were not present as they were in school.  When I arrived, infants were coloring, the 2-year-olds were at the table with loose parts, and the 3-, 4- and 5-year-olds were into free play.
