## **General Comments**

- -Visit to the learning center for an unexpected monitoring inspection
- -Ratio was respected during the visit
- -No hot beverage was found in the children's indoor and outdoor play area
- -Potty chair or training seat is provided, and a step or platforms are provided to allow children to reach regular sized toilets or sinks.
- -The children receiving services at a licensed facility has access to washrooms that include the following: (d) if 50 or more preschool children or school-age children are receiving the services, four toilets and four sinks
- -Toxic products, and cleaning supplies are locked and inaccessible to children
- -Monthly emergency evacuation and fire drills are completed
- -Smoke alarm, smoke detectors and fire extinguisher inspection and maintenance records
- -A monthly review and maintenance plan is completed on all stationary equipment showing: the review and repair dates; the action required and taken; and the name of the staff completing the review
- -New structure has been added in the playground, surfacing will need to be added. The operator will be looking into the manufacturer's manual to confirm how deep surfacing is needed. Children will not have access to the structures until the proper amount of surfacing is added.
- -Suggested to the educator in the two-year-old room to put crayons, scissors, glue...in a clear container so they easily have access and see the options offered to them.

Observations: When arriving to the center, two-year-old children and after-school kids were playing outside each in their playground. When coming in the two played in sensory bins and the afterschool painted and did a tower competition. The infants were playing with bubbles, they got ready and went outside. The three and fours went outside, came in and did an activity with insects, dry noodles, sand...etc. When leaving the center, all groups were eating their lunch.
