<ul style="list-style-type: none"> -Morning visit to the establishment for an unexpected monitoring inspection -During the visit, ratio child-to-staff is maintained and respected in same age and mixed age groups -Educator observed engaged with children at their level providing support and having conversations -The administrator as well as all educators have a valid first aid certificate -The administrator and 50% of the staff have their one-year Early childhood education certificate. -One new employee has been registered for her 90h-Introduction to early childhood -In all rooms, evidence of purposeful planning based on children's interest and learning, webbing, photos and learning stories were posted. -Children's indoor play area is safe and clean -Material and equipment proposed to children in the indoor play area are easily accessible on low, open shelves. It is varied and in sufficient quantity for all children present. -Daily incident log is maintained, parents are advised and signs the daily log -Incident report forms are completed and signed by the parent when in need to fill a reportable incident. The report is sent to the Department within 24hours following the incident and a copy is given to the parent. -Incident reports are maintained in the child's file -Out of 11 employees file, one file was missing the vulnerable sector check, the employee went and got it during the visit. Another employee renewal for the criminal-vulnerable sector check and SD check needs to be done. Once all documents received a copy will be sent to the licensing staff.

General Comments

Observations: When arriving at the center the infants were sitting at the table drawing, the three's and the four's were using the scissor's and the two's were just finishing a story. Once all activities were done, everyone had lunch and transitioned into naptime for the youngest and a quiet period for the oldest.
