- -Morning visit to the establishment for an unexpected monitoring inspection
- -During the visit ratio was respected in a mixed age group and a same age group
- -No infants are present at the center, Hand-foot and mouth is going around at the center, all infants have stayed home out of sickness. During the visit educators were sanitizing, the entire room
- -When acetaminophen is administered to a child, the written and signed by the parent consent is filled into the children file.
- -Administration of medication records are evident
- -Medication is in a locked box and stored in a storage in the four-year-old room inaccessible to children
- -Non-prescribed medication are in the original child safe container with the original label and labeled with the child's name and dosage
- -It was recommended to post in the classroom information on a child's allergy
- -Each child has an easily accessible space to store their personal belongings, which is labeled with their name and used only for the intended child
- -During the visit, it was observed that all educators are engaged with children at their level providing support and having conversations.
- -In the outdoor play area children have more than one type of surfacing to play and explore, the material offered is varied and in sufficient quantity for children present
- -Material and equipment offered to the preschool and infant playground is safe, clean and in good repair.
- -In the afterschool playground two climbing wall is damaged, boards are broken, and nails are exposed. The two-play structure were closed to the children by putting ribbon around it once the structures are fixed a picture will be sent to the QAM
- -The following administrative records are maintained on site: Financial records, daily attendance of children and staff, monthly emergency evacuation fire drills, smoke alarm, smoke detector and fire extinguisher inspection and maintenance records

Observations: When arriving at the center children were getting ready to go outside, after playing outside for
