I realize some of these items need purchased so please try to complete the below items on or before July 31st.

Comments: Please recover chair and small couch in first programming room or remove from circulation until repaired or discard. These items are torn and/or soiled and difficult to clean and sanitize. I would also recommend that staff add to your checklist cleaning of rubber mats and papertowel dispenser as children use these items and/or sit on them daily. Thank you.			
39(2) A licensed facility shall have a separate locked storage space that is inaccessible to the children for each of the following: (a) toxic products, chemical products and cleaning supplies;	39(2)(a)	Jul 15, 2020	
Comments: please ensure the rubbing alcohol is stored locked and out of reach of children. Thank you.

Household contact list is a requirement for PH, and I did not see household lists in child files.</p> <p>*Children were enjoying outdoor play during my visit. I would recommend spacing out some of the activities and stationary equipment so it allows enough area for children to throw balls between the hockey</p>
