General Comments

Licensing staff arrived at the licensed facility to conduct a license renewal inspection on June 20th, 2022.

When licensing staff arrived at the licensed facility, the preschool children were engaging in a group colour pattern activity. The children had snack and then had indoor free play due to the rain. During the indoor free play activities some children played in the dramatic play centre while other children went to build in the building centre. A couple of the children took some dramatic play materials into the building centre and the educators allowed the children incorporate dramatic play materials in the building area. Well done ladies!

Before the children were picked up for the day, the children and educators participated in two musical activities; the first being the "direction song." The children were seen tiptoeing, jumping and galloping along with the music. The second music activity consisted of the children "going on a bear hunt." The children were observed laughing and interacting with the music. The educators also followed along with the song and were observed laughing, jumping and tiptoeing along with the children.

Also, before getting picked up by their parents, the children practiced their graduation song!

Most of the children's files were complete with the required documentation and information. Please ensure that all files have a signed statement from the parents that they have read and understood all staff policies and procedures.

Please ensure that the protective surfacing surrounding the stationary equipment is tilled up and measured and if the surfacing is not at the depth recommended in the manufactures manual please replenish.

The sand boxes, located on the preschool playground, will need to be covered to keep the animals from defecating in the boxes at night to ensure the safety of the children.

Please ensure the pylons are used to block off the driveway during pick up time, as stipulated in the initial licensing report, to ensure the safety of the children as the driveway is in the middle of the afterschool playground.

Ensure the pylons are used during busy traffic times on the driveway, located in the middle of the afterschool outdoor play space, to ensure the safety of the children.
