General Comments

Upon the arrival of licensing staff for the renewal inspection, the after-school children were not yet present. Educators were observed boarding the Go-Go bus to pick them up from school.

The environment was tidy, well-organized, and prepared for the children's arrival. Available materials included board games, books, magnetic blocks, LEGO, toy vehicles, a dramatic play area, dolls, stuffed animals, and a craft station. A "Riddle of the Day" was posted on the chalkboard, adding an engaging and interactive element to the space. Additionally, a wall display showcased the current NHL playoff standings, reflecting the children's shared interests.

When the children arrived, they exited the bus and lined up. The bus driver was overheard offering encouraging words such as, "Good job today, have a great afternoon, see you tomorrow!" A head count was conducted, and sunscreen was applied to prepare for outdoor play.

Children were observed actively participating in activities including ball hockey, tag, making "flower soup," climbing on the monkey bars, and chatting in small groups. Educators were engaged, facilitating and participating in play. Additional outdoor materials such as scoops, balls, frisbees, and sand toys were also readily available.

One educator was observed attentively supporting a child who was experiencing strong emotions. The educator provided comfort, offering hugs and remaining present with the child during this time. Reminders for bathroom breaks and to refill water bottles were also provided.

Staff and child files were reviewed and found to comply. Positive child guidance were consistently observed throughout the visit.

Licensing staff recommends for renewal.
