General Comments

Upon the Inspectors arrival, the children were eating lunch together at the tables in the main space. After lunch, stations were set up with perler beads, colouring sheets, connector pieces and Lego. Please ensure that after lunch tables are cleaned prior to play material and stations being set up as it causes confusion to start an activity and then have the children stop to clean.

The play material in each room was tidy, organized and in good condition. Labels were on bins of open-ended material, loose play pieces, and children's artwork was on display. Allergies were clearly posted on a large Birthday mural and children's cubbies with personal belongings were clean.

Later in the afternoon, the children prepared to go outdoors to play in the wooded play area. Water bottles, the first aid kit and the attendance log were with the Educator and sunscreen was applied to each child. Before leaving the sidewalk, the children chose a partner to hold hands with and proceeded together to the wooded play area. Bright green safety vests were handed out to each child, and they all joined the Educator on the safety perimeter check singing "The Ants Go Marching". Children were observed enjoying the mud kitchens, running, looking for insects, and playing in the wooden playhouses. As a reminder, children respond positively to words of encouragement and praise. Please be mindful of the tone of voice being used while giving direction and guidance.

During inspection, child and staff files were verified and all required documentation was present. There was evidence of planning as activities were ready for the upcoming weeks in bins and a calendar was posted in the main entry way. Monthly fire drills are being completed and the evacuation plan was visibly posted in multiple areas. As additional safety precautions, it is recommended that the electrical room doors be locked, and a record of safety checks kept for the wooded play area.

Licensing staff recommends for renewal.
