<p>Licensing staff was screened for Covid-19 when she arrived at the licensed facility for a follow-up licensing inspection visit.</p> <p>When Licensing staff observed in the two year old classroom, the educators were observed interacting with the children at the child's level. The children were playing with a variety of activities. A group of children were building with coloured blocks while another group of children stood on stools and looked outside to see what they could see. The educators in this room recognized that the classroom was getting a bit chaotic and reacted by putting on music which immediately brought the noise level down in the classroom. After snack time, a group of children sat down to colour and draw with pencil crayons and paper while another group of children engaged in dramatic play in the kitchen center.</p> <p>While licensing staff was observing in the Junior three year old classroom, the children were engaging in outdoor play time. The children were exploring in the sand box, singing along to the music, playing with cars along with playing on the stationary equipment. The educators were observed interacting positively with the</p>

children while outside.

The educators in all classrooms were observed interacting with the children using positive child guidance techniques during the follow-up inspection visit.

The operator of the licensed facility shared with licensing staff that a number of educators were participating in a variety of online training as well as receiving extra guidance regarding positive child guidance and interacting positively with children.

All staff files were complete when licensing staff reviewed staff files during the follow-up inspection visit.
