Comments: While observing the children playing in the indoor learning environments, licensing staff noted mark-making materials in all classrooms however, only accessible to the children in two of the classrooms. Please ensure mark-making and craft materials are accessible to the children at all times.

Comments: Deficiency is now compliant While licensing staff was conducting observations in the indoor learning environments, some cleaning materials were being stored up high and out of the reach of children however, all cleaning materials are required to be stored in a locked cabinet or closet at all times to maintain the safety of the children.			

General Comments
Licensing staff arrived at the licensed facility to conduct the yearly license renewal inspection. Children were still arriving licensed facility for the day while conducting observations in the infant classroom.
The infants finished their snack had their diapers refreshed and had sunscreen applied before going outdoors to play in the outdoor learning environment. When outside, the educators put music on for the children. The children and educators sang songs and did the actions to the songs. The songs were "The Wheels on the Bus," "One Little Finger," "Baby Bumble Bee," "Parts of the Body," and "Akuna Matata."
The two- and three-year-old classroom children played outdoors in the outdoor play environment while licensing staff observed them. The children were playing in the wooden boat while other children played with the shovels and buckets behind the stationary equipment scooping and dumping pea rock. When the children and educators went indoors to get ready to eat lunch, one educator heated up lunches while the other educator read books to the children before the children washed up for their lunch. While eating their lunch the educators closed the curtains and put on classical music to slow down the pace of the classroom.
During lunch time, the infants and the two-year-old children were well supervised. The nap mats in each

classroom were more than forty-six centimetres apart. Two infants went to have their nap in the rest room as they are under 15 months of age.
