To be repaired / replaced.			

General Comments

A Monitoring Inspection was completed this afternoon. Upon arrival, the older children were joining the younger children, and everyone was getting ready for outdoor play. While outside, children were observed playing on the equipment, playing basketball, and looking for and collecting bugs. After returning inside, children were observed washing their hands and sitting at their tables for snack. After snack, children took part in several different learning invitations that had been set up for them – Painting, Lego, and a Butterfly Craft. Others were observed working on their homework, compiling a list of bugs that were found outside, writing stories, playing My Little Ponies, and drawing.

Discussed with educator and administrator: Maximum group size of 30 children. Upon QAM's arrival, children were in one large group. Educators were quick to split the children up into two separate groups. Room has a curtain that could be used to separate the room into two separate sections. Room is presently semi separated into two sides with tables and bookcases, and an opening at one end. Moving forward, when group size is over

30, two separate, clear groupings, must be put in place, and children must remain within their group, on their side of the room.
