 Comments: While observing the outside play area, it was observed that the mulch surfacing under the swings, was worn down. The outdoor play area had plenty of surfacing, but the surfacing under the swings was minimal, due to the number of children swinging during the school day. A conversation was had with educators regarding surfacing. Before the afterschool children are able to resume using the swings, educators are to ensure that there is enough surfacing. Educators to move some of the access surfacing, to under the swings. The purchasing of rakes is recommended. 								
General Comments								
A Monitoring Inspection was conducted this afternoon. The school aged children were observed inside, during snack and free play, transitioning to outside play, and during outside play.								
The two school aged rooms were set up with several well-defined learning / play centers. Some of these centers included the following: Arts & Crafts, Dramatic Play, Building & Transportation, and a Cozy Reading Center. Several forms of documentation were observed in both rooms - open ended art, photos, and learning stories. Flowers and plants were observed growing on the windowsill.
