General Comments
<p>A monitoring inspection occurred in the afternoon on the school-age program.</p> <p>Upon arrival ratio was taken by the Inspector in all three school-age learning environments.</p> <p>The Inspector observed that the children in the group in the cafeteria were engaged in art/creating flowers, building Lego and playing a game of cards.</p> <p>Inspector observed the children in room 154 building with magnet tiles, playing a game of "Trouble", interacting with Barbies, building with Lego, and creating art with markers, stickers, and glue.</p> <p>Inspector observed the children in room 155, building with Lego, socializing with their peers and outside play on the school playground.</p> <p>When outside play occurred, Inspector observed the children playing basketball, Ga-Ga ball, swinging on the swings and climbing on the school playground climbing structures.</p> <p>Discussed with onsite Administrator to review all children's files to ensure that all required information under the Early Childhood Services Act/Regulations is completed on child profiles and consent forms.</p> <p>Discussed reportable incident reports and reminded educators that if a child is injured at the childcare facility and the parent/guardian informs the childcare facility that the child was taken to the hospital to be observed, that a reportable incident report must be sent to the Quality Assurance Monitor. Also discussed that these must be completed and submitted to the Quality Assurance Monitor for an outbreak, unexpected facility closure, missing child, etc. Recommending reviewing Appendix 15 Incident Reports to be familiar when these must be submitted to EECD.</p> <p>Educators were observed using positive child guidance techniques when interacting and speaking with the children.</p>
