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General Comments
A renewal inspection was conducted during the afternoon session of the licensed program. Upon arrival at the school-age program, Licensing observed educators preparing the learning environments for the children's arrival. Once the children arrived, educators supported a smooth transition into the program by ensuring children washed their hands prior to entering the school-age environment. Children were observed engaged in a variety of age-appropriate activities, including building with LEGO and blocks, creating marble runs, playing card games, enjoying an afternoon snack, reading books, and participating in imaginative play with LOL dolls, accessories, and the dollhouse. Licensing also observed the school-age children utilizing the school playground area. Children were actively engaged in outdoor play, including the use of stationary playground equipment, Gaga ball, and soccer. All staff files were reviewed and verified to be complete, with all required documentation on file. A random review of twenty children's files was also conducted, and all required documentation and information were present. It is recommended that a parent information board be established in the cafeteria for families whose children access the program exclusively in that area. The board should include all required information, such as a copy of the license, inspection reports, contact information for Licensing and the Administrator, and the daily routine. Discussions occurred with the on-site Administrator and educators regarding enhancing the book and library area by incorporating additional non-fiction materials that reflect and support the current interests of the children. Licensing observed educators using positive child guidance practices throughout their interactions with the children, fostering a respectful and supportive environment.

General Comments

Based on observations made during the inspection and the review of required documentation, the school-age licence is recommended for renewal.
