Monitoring Inspection:

Children and educators observed engaged in a variety of activities this morning including dramatic play, water play, stories, playdoh and fine motor activities. The learning environment is set-up with a variety of invitations for the children to explore freely. The dramatic play area is set-up as a birthday party for the class stuffed cat. Children were observed pretending to bake a cake and wrap presents for the cat. The children are currently exploring photography and are encouraged to take photos of their experiences to revisit at the end of the day.

Purposeful planning is evident through documentation, photos, invitations and materials added to the environment that support the children's current interests (Pete the Cat, pets and stuffies, birthday parties and photography).

Cereal with milk was served for morning snack. Children were encouraged to serve their own snack. Handwashing routines observed before snack.

Daily attendance forms were observed to be complete and accurate. Monthly fire drills are documented.
