Comments: During the renewal inspection, the inspector observed that the description of duties and responsibilities is missing in 3 of the 5 staff members files verified. During the inspection, the operator placed a copy of the duties and responsibilities in each staff members file. Deficiency is now compliant.

Comments: During the renewal inspection, the inspector observed that 1 of the 5 staff members file contained an expired cardiopulmonary resuscitation (CPR) certificate. During the inspection, the operator placed a copy of a valid first aid (FA) certificate and a valid cardiopulmonary resuscitation (CPR) certificate in the employees' file. Deficiency is now compliant.

facility to ensure the safety of the children. Image: Comments: During the renewal inspection, the inspector observed that the outdoor play area is icy, and snow covered creating a slipping hazard. During the inspection, an educator distributed sand around the outdoor play area. Deficiency is now compliant.							

General Comments

During the renewal inspection, the inspector observed, outdoor free play while another group of children were out in the neighborhood on a walk. The inspector also observed lunch, quiet time, and indoor free play.

During the renewal inspection, the inspector observed that a group of children are indirectly supervised. When children are indirectly supervised, staff members must always know where children are and frequently check on them to guarantee safety. The inspector noted that these children seem to have access to the kitchen; therefore, the inspector recommends unplugging the oven and making utensils such as knives inaccessible to children.

The inspector was informed that planning for a mixed-age group which includes preschool aged children and school age children is mostly focused on preschool aged children; however, school aged children are invited to partake in these activities. During the inspection, staff stated that participation of school age children in these activities is low. To increase participation of all children, the daily program should include a variety of activities purposely planned according to the ages and development of the children. The Quality Assurance Monitor will explore this element with the operator during the next monitoring inspection.

During the inspection, the inspector observed an educator picking a child by their arms, the inspector had a discussion with the educator and the operator on how to safely lift a child up to avoid any injuries.

The ground was snow covered at the time of inspection; therefore, the park assessment will be conducted in the spring with a member of the licensing team.
