General Comments
Operator engages in conversation with the children and uses manners at all times when requesting the children to do something. The children are given opportunities to engage in several different experiences. Operator has each child providing a snack experience for the other children this week the which they are preparing themselves.
Operator locks up medication that belongs to the household. She does not administer any medication to children. Advised operator that if medication is required to be put into the fridge for their family, it would have to be put in a lock box during operating hours.
Operator stated that they provide both lunch and snacks for the children. Operator stated she posts all changes to the menu on their face book page. Please ensure that changes to menu are being documented on a hard copy at facility for the review by Departmental staff.
The filing system is meticulous and complete. Operator is organized and is able to demonstrate the maintenance of all records.

General Comments

Toxic products are being locked with a magnetic lock which is not considered a secure way to keep toxic products out of the reach of children. Advised operator that toxics need to be put under lock and key. Operator stated that she would find a space to do this.

Please ensure that a pre planned documented program is being used. Operator stated that they use social media to advise parents of what activities or learning is being incorporated into the children's day however advised operator that a physical pre-program is required at the facility that builds upon the children's interests. However, evidence of the New Brunswick Curriculum Framework is evident in the facility.

Operator is keeping a very detailed incident log complete with pictures of the injury. Operator stated that she has had no reportable incident to report but knows that these kinds of incidents must be detailed on Departmental incident report forms.

Outdoor play area is snow covered and cannot be inspected thoroughly. There is no visible hazards that would prevent children from playing outdoors in specified areas.
