Comments: During the renewal inspection, the Quality Assurance Monitor observed that the Medicare number is missing in 1 of the 4 child files verified. Each child record must include a Medicare number. While the Quality Assurance Monitor was still on site, the parent of the child in question arrived at the facility and included the Medicare number in the child file. Deficiency is now compliant			
24(1) For the purposes of subsection 20(1) of the Act, the following records and documents shall be maintained on the premises of a licensed facility: (b) child records that include: (iv) the name, address and telephone number of at least two individuals authorized by the child's parent or guardian to pick up the child and to be contacted in case of an emergency if the parent or guardian cannot be reached,	24(1)(b)(iv)	May 30, 2025	
Comments: During the renewal inspection, the Quality Assurance Monitor observed that the 2 emergency contacts have the same telephone number in 1 of the 4 child files verified. In each child file, the 2 emergency contacts must have a different telephone number.			
24(1) For the purposes of subsection 20(1) of the Act, the following records and documents shall be maintained on the premises of a licensed facility: (j) smoke alarm, smoke detector and fire extinguisher inspection and maintenance records.	24(1)(j)	May 30, 2025	
Comments: During the renewal inspection, the Quality Assurance Monitor observed that although monthly verifications of fire safety equipment are being completed, two fire extinguisher labels are expired since January 2025. The operator stated that all fire extinguishers are inspected annually by Fire Safety in June and will follow up on the discrepancy regarding the outdated labels. The operator must ensure that fire extinguishers are verified and receive the new label every year by Fire Safety.			
27 An operator of a licensed facility shall obtain the written consent of a parent or guardian of a child receiving services at the licensed facility before doing any of the following: (b) permitting, in the case of illness or soiled clothing, the child to shower or bathe or showering or bathing the child.	27(b)	May 30, 2025	
Comments: During the renewal inspection, the Quality Assurance Monitor observed that a consent for bathing or showering in the event of illness or soiled clothing is missing in 1 of the 4 child files verified. In each child file, that the consent for bathing or showering in the event of illness or soiled clothing is filed out by the parents.

Comments: During the renewal inspection, the Quality Assurance Monitor observed 2 water bottles that were not labelled with the name of the child. Personal belongings must be labelled with the name of the child. The operator immediately labelled the 2 water bottles with the name of the child. Deficiency is now compliant
