<p>General Comments</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> -Morning visit to the establishment for an unexpected monitoring inspection -Ratio was respected during the visit -Posted in the entrance on the first floor and in the cubbies area on the second floor are the following documents: The license, inspection report, orders for compliance, daily routine, evacuation procedures, name of administrator, name and telephone number of QA Monitor and inspector - Life threatening allergies -When it applies a notice to inform parents of the existence of a communicable disease is posted on the entrance door -The administrator as well as all educators have a valid first aid certificate -More than 50% of the staff have their one-year Early childhood education certificate -The following administrative records are maintained on site: Financial records, daily attendance of children and staff, monthly emergency evacuation fire drills, smoke alarm, smoke detectors and fire extinguisher inspection and maintenance records -Monthly emergency evacuation and fire drills are completed -A monthly review and maintenance plan is completed on all stationary equipment -Exemption form was sent to the operator since the financial records are not kept on site but at the main center. -In all rooms, evidence of purposeful planning based on children's interest and learning, invitation, photos and learning stories were posted. -During the visit, it was observed that all educators are engaged with children at their level providing support and having conversations. Open-end questions are asked and guidance is given in a respectful and kind way -Children's indoor play area is safe and clean. -Material and equipment proposed to children in the indoor play area are easily accessible on low, open shelves. It is varied and in sufficient quantity for all children present. -Two hot beverages were found in the art room on the main level; they were put away during the visit. Staff was

reminded that hot beverages need to be in a sealed cup.

Observations: When arriving at the center children were eating their snack, they all went for a walk in the neighborhood and then arriving at the center they had a free play period. They were getting ready for lunch when I was leaving.
