Comments: Licensing observed that two children were present but not recorded on the Daily Attendance Record. The Daily Attendance Record is required to be completed at each arrival and departure. The educator recorded the two children during the inspection. Deficiency is now compliant			

General Comments
<p>A monitoring inspection occurred in the afternoon.</p> <p>The children were observed in both the indoor and outdoor environments, including during transitions between the two. The children were also observed eating snack, with hand washing occurring beforehand.</p> <p>Infant Room: The children were observed playing with animal figurines, building with blocks, and sitting with their educator while reading a book. Educators indicated that the children are currently showing interest in playdough, sand play, music, books, and animals.</p> <p>Two-Year-Old Room: The children were observed looking at dinosaur books, drawing at the table, and eating snack prior to transitioning outdoors. Educators indicated that the children are currently interested in dinosaurs and art activities.</p> <p>Three-Year-Old Room: The children were observed outdoors, engaged in a variety of activities including climbing on the tires, digging in the sand, sitting in the hammocks, and jumping in puddles.</p> <p>Four-Year-Old Room: The children were observed eating snack before transitioning outdoors. The children shared with licensing that they are currently interested in flowers and seeds, as well as games such as Duck Duck Goose, number match, tag, and action dice games. Educators also shared that the group has begun participating in weekly visits to the nursing home through a program called "Nursing Home Without Walls."</p>

General Comments

School Age: The children were observed eating snack while preparing for show and tell. The children shared with licensing that they are currently interested in art and crafts, colouring, building with Lego, board games (specifically chess), and playing with their peers.

A clearly visible and prominent area was designated for the posting of the facility license, current monitoring reports, and any orders for compliance. Additional documents reviewed included incident logs, daily attendance records, three educator files and records of evacuation and monthly fire drills.

A conversation took place with the Administrator regarding the following:

- Educators are to ensure that children's learning is visible and current within the classroom through ongoing documentation.
