Comments: The dome, the wood climbing structure and plastic climber all require 30 cm's, six feet all around of protective surfacing. Please see Operator Manual for protective surfacing options.			

General Comments
<p>Upon my arrival, the children were just arriving from school. The educator went outside to welcome them off the bus. The children came back inside, had lunch and then did some coloring.</p> <p>The educator is attentive and engaged with the children. He sat at the table with them and colored. Positive child guidance was observed such as gentle reminders, encouragements and re-direction when needed.</p> <p>The children went outside around 2:00 pm they were enjoying the nice weather. The educator was engaged and played basketball with them. Around 2:20 they came back inside and had snack. Prior to snack they were asked to wash their hands.</p> <p>I would recommend that the floor be replaced/ repaired/ deep cleaned. There are many cracks in the floor, especially in the bathrooms, and large stains that don't seem to be removable.</p> <p>I would also recommend that new materials be added. Please refer to appendix 24 of the Operator Manual. New books that are more current and of interest to the children, more dramatic play materials and items for science and nature learning would be favorable for the children.</p> <p>Mop and buckets must be stored away from the classrooms.</p> <p>Ensure that toys and toy bins are moved and that you clean and broom behind them. Also ensure large plastic</p>

items such as the kitchen and crib are also cleaned daily.

In the outdoor space, the plastic kitchens are aging, and parts are broken, therefore, should be removed/replaced. I would recommend additional materials outside for the children such as tools for the mud kitchen like bowls, scoops, pans etc.
