General Comments

Licensing staff arrived at the facility for a follow up. Upon arrival, the children were sitting at the table drawing their favourite book. The educators were engaging in conversation with the children and were heard praising their drawings. One educator then sat down in the cozy corner to read books with the children who had finished the activity. The children took their turns using the washroom before lining up to go outside. The children got their snowsuits on and the ones who were leaving before lunch packed their belongings. The educators brought the attendance sheet and backpack out. Some children used the shovels, buckets, and muffin pans and were seen making cupcakes with the rocks, mud, and dirt. Other children were seen playing on the play structure, climbing, going down the slide, and running around. The educators were spaced out and playing with the children. The children were heard laughing. The educators greeted the parents and updated the attendance sheet as the children left.

The children and educator then cleaned up the toys and went to play in the woods. The children were seen exploring the trees and playing with the ice that had frozen the pans. The children then returned inside for lunch. The children got their snowsuits off and washed their hands. The educator sat at the table with the children and ate with them. After lunch, the children engaged in free play. The children were seen making a hide-out with blocks and some were drawing. The children engaged in imaginary play. They were seen pretending to be Super Mario and were seen incorporating the hide-out and doctor toys into their play. An educator helped the children make their hide-out bigger so they could all fit inside.

General Comments

The educators are attentive to the children and say please and thank you when talking to them. Only positive child guidance was observed.
