**General Comments**

Monitoring visit performed. No compliances to address on the day of my visit. Covid guidelines are being followed and visitor log sheet was signed. PH guidelines recommend that educators sign in on the group attendance sheet for the children they supervise for contact tracing. Educators do sign in on their staff attendance record also.

I reviewed administrative records during my visit and attendance, toddler info sheets, fire drills, outdoor check lists tracked on a monthly. New staff records were also reviewed and FA certificates have been updated. One staff is registered to renew the FA certificate this weekend.

This facility remains in continuation of license while waiting for Fire and Health reports. Once these have been received, a renewal license will be issued.

Babies were outdoors earlier this AM and during my visit they were involved in a variety of activities - playing house, playing with farm animals and learning their names, painting activity. Lots of wonderful interaction observed. The babies were observed going for nap after lunch.

All other children 2's, preschool and school age were observed in outdoor play this AM. All children came indoors, washed hands, before eating lunch. The 2's will be doing a sorting activity this afternoon. Looks like fun especially for this age group.

The babies and 2's were observed going down for nap, and the 3 and 4 age group after lunch enjoyed some quiet time activities. The educator set up stations for reading, playing dolls, nature/sensory materials, puzzles, and coloring. The school age group are attending FT due to the strike and the educators have taken this into account when organizing programming opportunities to ensure children have ample activities to participate in. In the AM, when school age children arrive they have free choice of activities, then eat snack and 1 hour of time is allotted for school work in the AM. In the PM, they will spend time on reading homework and back outdoors. Educators were observed engaged, interested, treating children with kindness, asking and answering questions, interacting and involved in children's learning. This centre is very inviting, organized, and offer a variety of learning experiences and outdoor play is incorporated daily into the programming.
