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General Comments Licensing Staff arrived at the facility to conduct the Renewal Inspection. Upon arrival, all classes were having morning snack. The indoor environment was organized and welcoming. Defined play areas such as building centres, dress up and dramatic play centre, sensory areas and a cozy corner with books was observed in all classes. As the classes finished morning snack, they transitioned to the outdoor play space. In the infant room, sunscreen was applied before the group went outside. Before leaving the classroom, the Educator ensured all infants had their hats and water bottles. In the older classes, a large bin with sunscreen bottles was brought outside. A new table and chairs have been added to the infant outdoor play environment. Both the infant and preschool playground have large storage bins with play materials such as balls, trucks, shovels and indestructible books. All materials were observed to be in good condition. The Educators were engaged with the children and their activities. One Educator was observed playing football with a group of children and teaching them different techniques. The groups transitioned inside one at a time, starting with the infants. Proper diaper changing procedures and hand washing was observed. One Educator sat with the infant's singing songs while they waited for their peers to finish washing hands. Lunch was observed in all classrooms. It is evident the classes are familiar with the daily routine. As the children finished eating, those who napped transitioned to their cot or playpen while the older classes engaged in a variety of activities. One class was building wooden flowerpots and painting them while the other class played with gems and Lego. One Educator sat and read "Brer rabbit gets tricked" to a small group of children. Only positive child guidance techniques were observed today. Staff and child files were verified. Weekly planning sheets, artwork, learning stories and pictures of the children were observed in all classrooms. Licensing Staff recommends for Renewal.
