A monitoring inspection occurred today. The children were observed during indoor play, snack and playing in the gym. In the indoor environment children were observed engaged with Lego, LOL dolls, board games, drawing and hanging with their peers. During their time in the gym, the children were observed playing with the parachute, scoops/ball game, running, and jump rope. Positive interactions between the Educators and the children were also observed.
