## **General Comments**

A Monitoring Inspection occurred September 22, 2025

The children were observed engaging in a variety of activities across both indoor and outdoor environments, including transitions between the two.

Indoors, the children were seen building a structure and racing cars down it, playing board games, and drawing in the classroom. In the gym, they participated in soccer, football, and tug-of-war.

Outdoors, the children were observed using the stationary equipment, playing in the newly added Gaga ball pit, playing soccer, and building forts in the wooded area.

Educators indicated that the children's current interests include iron beads, loom bracelet making, board games, building with wooden blocks, and sports.

A clearly visible and designated area was used for posting the facility license, current monitoring reports, and any orders for compliance. Additional documents reviewed included incident logs, daily attendance records, and records of evacuation and monthly fire drills.

A conversation took place with the administrator regarding the following:

• While observing the outdoor play area, it was noted that the pea gravel surfacing under the swings was worn down. Educators to ensure adequate surfacing is in place before the after-school children resume using the
