Comments: The inspector observes new shelves in the indoor play area, stocked with a variety of materials and equipment that are diverse and in sufficient quantity for all children present. Deficiency is now compliant.			
48(2) An operator of a licensed facility may supply food to a child receiving services at the licensed facility that a parent or guardian of the child brings from the child's home if the food is labelled with the child's name and refrigerated, as required.	48(2)	Aug 06, 2025	
Comments: The inspector verified 15 lunchboxes and found that 6 were not labeled with the children's names. It is recommended that a reminder be communicated to parents to label their children's lunchboxes.			

General Comments
Inspector is onsite to complete a follow up inspection. An educator shares a summer 'bucket list' created by the children, outlining the activities they wish to participate in. As it is Electronic Day, some children are observed using tablets and cellphones after lunch, while others are engaged in drawing activities. Educators are observed interacting positively with the children. Outdoor play is planned for later in the afternoon.
