During time of inspection children were observed playing outside. The outdoor play surface is frozen so the children can't use the outdoor play equipment. The toys and materials were put away for the winter. Inspector advised that a sufficient quantity of toys and materials for the outdoor play area need to be accessible year-round. Inspector recommend they add a variety of toys and materials for the winter months.
