## **General Comments**

When I arrived, everyone was either outside or getting ready to go outside. When they came back inside, they had a snack and the children who nap, had a nap and the others were playing quietly.

The rooms are clean and organized. Staff were observed cleaning/disinfecting often throughout the inspection.

Children were asked to wash their hands before meals.

The educators were engaged with the children indoors and outdoors, playing with them, talking with them. They were heard having positive conversations with the children such as providing encouraging words and acknowledging accomplishments.

Purposely planned program is evident and documented. There are children's art projects on the walls and learning stories are also posted around the Centre.

A reminder that classrooms must contain the flowing: (operator manual 9.2.2 Indoor play area materials and equipment):

Open ended play materials and equipment in sufficient quantity and variety for the size of the group and representative of each of the following categories is present: • art materials including loose parts; • blocks and accessories; • language and literacy; • dramatic play; • music and movement; • large muscle (gross motor); • manipulative and fine motor; • sand and water play; • puzzles and games; • materials that support mathematical learning; and • materials that support learning in science and technology.

The outdoor playground was inspected and meets regulation. That said, the playground is divided in stations, but the stations are not equipment with all the materials required for its indented use. Ex: the chalk board doesn't have chalk crayons. The magnetic board doesn't have any magnets, the music area doesn't have any instruments or tools to make music and the building area doesn't have any building blocks/wood. Those items need to be added to the playground to ensure the children can use the stations as intended and to ensure there

is sufficient materials outside for them to play with.

I recommend for renewal.
