This may look like a journal, calendar or notebook and should include notes about projects that have they planned, invitations they have set up, interests of the children, materials that have been added or need to be add to their environment, games, children's ideas, etc. QA Monitor will be looking for this on next Monitoring Inspection.

Discussed with supervisor challenging the staff to include more open ended art opportunities rather than planned crafts. This allows the children to express their creativity.
