## **General Comments**

I, inspector Kelsey Colford, accompanied by quality assurance monitor, Megan Munden, completed the regional inspection. When we arrived, the children were playing outside at a water table, actively engaged with the educator who was playing with them at the table. At the time we arrived one educator was cleaning up inside for several minutes while the other educator was in the outdoor play area with five children under the age of two. Child-to-staff ratio was maintained throughout the rest of the visit and all educators were consistently patient and engaging with the children. They encouraged exploration and both independent and group play. They talked to the children throughout activities and transitions such as diaper changes and preparing lunches. They encouraged independence as much as possible with changing shoes and eating lunch but were there to readily assist when needed. Educators explained what they were doing as they did it, asked the children questions, and sang songs with the children, including "Old McDonald" and "Head & Shoulders, Knees & Toes". The children were clearly familiar with these songs and joined in.

Transition from outside to lunch time and then lunch time to naptime were smooth. One educator took the kids one a time in for diaper changes and clean-up from outdoor play, while the other educator prepared lunches and kept the other kids singing and talking. They sat with the kids throughout lunch and talked with them. They encouraged and celebrated the children using their language and expanding their speech.

The indoor space was clean, well-organized, and all individualized spaces and items such as storage hooks and diaper changing supplies were labelled for each child. The indoor play space was warm and inviting with photos of the children, recent art projects completed by the children, and a wide variety of toys, books, and activities that were all at eye-level for the children. All staff and children's files were well-organized and up-to-date.
