The educators were actively engaged with the children during the visit. After the children were finished with snack one educator took the children in to change their diapers and get them ready to play outside, one at a time, and spoke to the child during this. The other educator engaged with the remaining children, encouraging their exploration of the many toys and books available at the children's level. She sat on their level and read with the children and encouraged their naming of animals in the books and their knowledge of what sounds the animals make. They had replaced their previous art projects with new art projects since my last visit. These were displayed on the walls at eye-level for the children, demonstrating the children's recent learning.

After everyone was ready the group went outside where they enjoyed playing with their water table. Their educators helped them learn to use new squirt toys which required them to pull a dinosaur to draw the water in and then push it to squirt the water out. The children were free to explore the rest of their play area and available toys and chose to enjoy some time digging with various play tools as well.
