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General Comments

Monitoring visit performed.

Upon arrival children had finished snack. Educator was supervising play while another educator was changing children's bottoms and washing hands before getting ready for outdoor play. Educator engages with playful conversation while changing children's diapers. Toys and equipment is arranged and easily accessible to children. A new busy/music centre was installed on the wall in the play area. Lots of children's learning stories were posted and some programming was visible for parents to view in the cubby area.

Appropriate child guidance was observed. Educator has a calming demeanor when redirecting children's negative behavior -"remember we don't hit our friends" as she comforts the other child", then she invites the other child to come over and say sorry by saying "Give your friend a hug".

Administrative records were reviewed and all in order with exception of staff attendance. It was determined that staff child ratio was not in accordance with regulations and was not being maintained in the early part of the day. This was corrected at 8:15AM when the second staff arrived to work.

A sand play area was added to the outdoor play area. I did notice that the new wooden storage box did not have a cover. I would recommend one, so toys are protected from the weather. The educator mentioned with a heavy wooden lid it might be unsafe. There are probably other options vs using a heavy wooden cover.

General Comments

Children were observed playing outside in the house centre, scooping up rocks, dancing about, and also helped with clean up before moving indoors for lunch. Children enjoyed exploring their outdoor play environment before moving indoors for lunch and then a nap. Children waited eagerly to eat lunch while educators washed hands and heated up their food brought from home. Educators were observed feeding children that needed assistance.
