General Comments

Upon Licensing staff arrival for the annual renewal inspection, the children were sitting together for morning snack at a small table and in highchair. Educators were observed offering positive words of encouragement such as "good job with eating your banana" and singing. After snack, the floors were swept, the tables and highchairs were cleaned, and proper diaper changing procedures were observed.

The main play space was welcoming and tidy. Play material such as dolls, a play kitchen with accessories, books, a cozy child size couch, wooden blocks and puzzles, a wedge climber, and balls were in good condition and easily accessible. Family photos, children's artwork and learning stories were on display. Binders were organized for each child with documentation of learning and the daily routine was posted.

Later in the morning, Educators welcomed a guest volunteer reader. The children gathered around and listened to two stories and were eager to interact and join in. After stories, the children were observed having free play. The children were observed reading with an Educator, playing with dolls, colourful shapes, and wooden blocks. Gentle reminders were heard on being kind to friends and to use gentle hands while playing. Positive child guidance and positive redirection was observed during inspection. Warm hugs and caring words of affirmation were observed when Educators comforted children who were working through some feelings.

Before lunch, Educators prepared the nap space and proper diaper changing procedures were again observed. At lunch, the children again sat all together while an Educator prepared their lunches brought from home. Educators were actively engaged with the children and were observed signing nursery rhyme songs with the children. There was evidence of a daily routine as transition times were smooth between key moments during the day Educators actively communicated with each other.

During inspection, staff and child files were verified. The parent board in the main entry way contained all required licensing documentation. Monthly fire drills are being recorded and the daily attendance form was completed. As a reminder, your designated rest area is to remain separate from the main play space.

Licensing staff recommend for renewal.
