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<p>General Comments</p> <p>Licensing Staff arrived at the facility to conduct the Renewal Inspection. Upon arrival only one infant had arrived. One Educator was sitting at the table as the infant ate morning snack while the other Educator was observed cleaning and organizing the indoor environment.</p> <p>The indoor environment was clean, bright and welcoming. Several positive changes have been made to the classroom; the walls have all been painted, new play materials have been added, and the layout has changed to ensure all materials are accessible to the infants. A new sensory table has been added to the class. The sensory bins contained plastic bugs, leaves, flowers, bug catchers and plastic tweezers. The infant was observed laughing and smiling as they filled and dumped the bins.</p> <p>Diaper changes were observed before the group transitioned outside to play. Sunscreen was applied; hats and the first aid kit was brought outside. During outdoor play more infants arrived for the day. While playing outside the infants showed an interest in the play kitchen, scooping rocks into mixing bowls and pretending to eat play food. The Educators were heard singing songs such as "Old MacDonald had a Farm" with the group. The transition back inside the facility to prepare for lunch time was smooth. Hands were washed and lunches were heated before the Educator sat at the table offering assistance. The Educator engaged with the infants as they ate, encouraging their independence with utensils and checking in to see if they were full or wanted more to eat. Once the infants had finished eating, hands and faces were cleaned with warm face cloths, and the infants went into the nap room to lay down on their cot. The infants settled quickly for nap time.</p> <p>Staff and child files were verified on site today and contained all required documents. Monthly fire drills are being conducted and recorded as well as a monthly outdoor maintenance check. Only positive child guidance was observed today. The Educators were engaged with the infants throughout the Inspection, singing nursery rhymes, offering hugs, rubbing their backs and offering words of encouragement and praise.</p> <p>Licensing Staff recommend for renewal.</p>
