The Quality Assurance Monitoring has referred the educator to the Operator Manual Appendix 24 for ideas. The classroom should be adapted for all of the ages who are using it. The Quality Assurance Monitor has made the recommendation of making a zone or a space just for the school age children to further their sense of belonging.			

General Comments The Quality Assurance Monitor is on site for a monitoring inspection follow-up. While on site, the Quality Assurance Monitor was able to observe the children during the outdoor play. There was proper supervision during the visit and the Quality Assurance monitor was able to observe the educator using positive interventions.
