Comments: No covers for infant and preschool outdoor play area sand boxes.

Comments: Creative art materials lacking in preschool rooms. A variety of open-ended art materials must be available and accessible for the children to use daily. Examples of materials to include, but not limited to: paper (different, sizes, colours and textures), collage material, popsicle sticks, loose parts, collectibles from nature, yarn, recycled items, tape. Ensure that materials are age appropriate and safe for the age of the children in the group. Recommend using divided trays so children can easily access the materials.

A balance of indoor and outdoor activities were observed today. Educators were observed to respond to children during play by engaging in back and forth conversation as they supported and encouraged their play. During transitions and daily routines educators provided choice and encouragement to the children.
