General Comments

A Monitoring Inspection occurred on June 3, 2024, in the afternoon.

During this time, children were observed during indoor and outdoor free play and nap time. Educators mentioned that the children in the Butterfly Room are currently very excited about their special upcoming graduation celebration. Positive language and gentle reminders were used by the educators, who also included their own interests in their documentation. Outside, educators played an active role in the children's activities.

Parents of children at the center are allowed entry at any time. The center has a clearly visible and prominent place for posting the license, current inspection report, monitoring reports, and orders for compliance. Each room has a posted daily routine, and there is a notice informing parents about the existence of a communicable disease, which is also clearly visible.

The Caterpillar Room is set up in an inviting manner, with materials arranged to encourage children to play. Ideas from web learning stories are reflected in the art, library, kitchen, and dramatic play areas. Books have been carefully selected to reflect the children's interests. The children's work is displayed at eye level, with their names and dates included. The facility boasts a varied supply of appropriate equipment, materials, books, and toys. Several well-defined learning centers for activities such as building, reading, dramatic play, and science were observed, with children's artwork displayed throughout the facility. Sensory areas are available in sufficient quantities for play, with accessories provided.
