General Comments

Licensing staff arrived at the licensed early learning and childcare home while the children and the operator were engaging in free play activities.

The operator made a game for the children to play with. The game consisted of a "swirl" drawing, on a plain piece of paper, with blue, green and red dots evenly spaced on the "swirl." When the operator asked the children what they thought the "swirl" drawing looked like, one child stated it looked like Christmas lights. The operator also drew a solid blue circle, a solid red hand and a green, long thick drawn line, that the children said looked like a "stick." The operator pointed at the first coloured dot (on the "swirl" drawing and the children had to either pound the blue circle, "high-five" the red hand or karate-chop the green stick depending on the colour of the dot. The children enjoyed playing this game and were able to go faster each time they played.

Licensing staff observed an abundance of evidence of learning posted on the walls at the child's level so the children could look at and revisit their learning experiences.

The indoor learning environment was welcoming. There were plants, music playing and invitations of play set up for the children to engage with.

After free play activities, the children showed licensing staff their outdoor playground in the back yard of the home. The playground had a new wooden playhouse where some accessories for the outdoor kitchen were being stored on a shelf. There were multiple steel bowls, metal pots and pans along with wooden cups. While in the backyard, the children rolled over the logs that define the perimeter of the pea rock, to look for worms, slugs, bugs, etc. One of the children spotted a baby slug and picked it up for the other children to touch.

The children, Operator and licensing staff walked to the local park for the children to play before going back to the home to have their picnic lunch in the back yard. While at the park, the children joined other children from neighboring early and learning and childcare homes in a group craft activity. The group craft activity consisted of paint sticks, pastels, crayons, tissue paper, glue long paper taped to the surface of the picnic table.

Once the children satiated from the craft activity two groups of children went on a scavenger hunt for painted
